The Township will NOT be collecting tires. Pride Day events include blood pressure checks by the Ambulance District along with Fire District with equipment and meet your local Sheriff Deputy Krueger. Information will be available by different local agencies including Herrick Memorial Library, the Southern Satellite Office on Aging and more. Refreshments will be served inside the Maintenance Facility. This event is in coordination with the Lorain County Commissioners and the Lorain County Solid Waste Management District.
